

RESOLUTION

WHEREAS: The City of Elberton maintains storm sewer; and

WHEREAS: A portion of this storm sewer collection system is located in the Locklin Street area and is in need of extensive repair and is within an area where the majority of residents are low to moderate income; and

WHEREAS: Failure to perform these needed repairs and rehabilitation expose the residents in this area to risk to their health and well being; and

WHEREAS: The cost of repair and rehabilitation of this portion of the storm sewer collection system is estimated to be in excess of \$401,850; and

WHEREAS: The City of Elberton currently does not have adequate funds available to finance these repairs; and

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the City of Elberton hereby authorize the Mayor and/or City Manager to apply for a Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) for FY 2007 through the Georgia Department of Community Affairs (DCA) for the purpose of funding repairs and rehabilitation to the City of Elberton storm sewer collection system in the Locklin Street area (the project) and hereby delegates to the Mayor and/or City Manager authority to execute all documents necessary to apply for and obtain the CDBG Grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Mayor and Council of the City of Elberton hereby appropriates 10% (ten percent) of the amount of the CDBG Application over \$3000,000 as a local match for the project.
