

## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS:** The City of Elberton owns a Peak Shaving Plant facility (the "Facility") as part of its natural gas system; and

**WHEREAS:** The Facility is no longer of any use or value to the natural gas system, and the City will incur a significant level of cost to maintain the Facility and bring it into compliance with Federal regulations; and

**WHEREAS:** The City of Elberton wishes to maintain the property and building for potential industry and/or commercial development; and

**WHEREAS:** Council wishes to declare the propane tanks and equipment that are located on the property surplus and no longer of any value to the City of Elberton.

**NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Elberton City Council that the tanks and equipment be declared as surplus and disposed of in accordance with prescribed city policies.

**UNANIMOUSLY ADOPTED** at the Regular Meeting of the Mayor and Council on May 7, 2007 and June 4, 2007.
