

**A RESOLUTION
BY THE CITY OF ELBERTON, GEORGIA
TO AWARD THE CONSTRUCTION CONTRACT FOR THE SALVATION ARMY GRAVITY
SEWER REPLACEMENT; AND TO ALSO AUTHORIZED THE CITY MANAGER AND CITY
CLERK TO SIGN APPROPRIATE DOCUMENTS FOR PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION**

WHEREAS, the City of Elberton, Georgia has planned a sewer project over the past year known as the Salvation Army Gravity Sewer Replacement; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elberton authorized its consulting engineers, Precision Planning, Inc., to develop detailed plans and specifications for the project; and

WHEREAS, said plans and specifications have been approved by the appropriate agency; and

WHEREAS, the City of Elberton appropriately advertised the project for bids; and

WHEREAS, bids were opened and read aloud publicly on the 14th of June, 2007 at the City of Elberton City Hall; and

WHEREAS, the engineers have checked and tabulated the bids and contractor references; and

WHEREAS, the engineers have made a recommendation of award to the lowest and best bidder, Tugaloo Pipeline of Westminster, South Carolina; and

WHEREAS, it is incumbent upon the City to begin construction of the project at the earliest possible date.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City of Elberton to award the sewer project to Tugaloo Pipeline in the amount of TWO HUNDRED FORTY-ONE THOUSAND, NINE HUNDRED SEVENTY-TWO AND 30/100 DOLLARS (\$241,972.30).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED to authorize the City Manager and City Clerk to sign all documents necessary for the implementation of the proposed project.

This Resolution was passed by a quorum of the City of Elberton this 9th day of July, 2007.
