

## RESOLUTION

**WHEREAS:** There will be a Municipal General Election held on November 3, 2009 to elect a Mayor and Council Member each from Ward One, Four and Five; and

**WHEREAS:** The Official Code of Georgia, annotated, requires the Mayor and Council to set a qualifying fee that shall be three percent (3%) of the total compensation received by the officials in the preceding calendar year, which is \$356.64 for Mayor and \$266.64 for Council Member; and

**WHEREAS:** The Georgia State Election Board, Sections 21-2-380.1, instructs the governing authority of each municipality to appoint and certify the appointment of an Election Superintendent/Absentee Ballot Clerk to the Secretary of State's Office; and

**WHEREAS:** The governing authority shall designate the City Clerk as Election Superintendent/Absentee Ballot Clerk; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED,** and it is hereby resolved that the Mayor and Council of the City of Elberton do hereby issue a call for a Municipal General Election to be held on November 3, 2009, which will be conducted under the Georgia Code as amended.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Mayor and Council of the City of Elberton do hereby adopt the qualifying fee and the appointment of the Elections Superintendent/Absentee Ballot Clerk as stated above as required by the Georgia State Election Board.
