**BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND DULY ELECTED COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF ELBERTON, GEORGIA, AS FOLLOWS:**

Poole deserves a special honor for his proven commitment and dedication to public safety and the citizens of Elberton for his many years of service as Fire Chief and in the many other roles he served such as Zoning Administrator, Elections Superintendent, and as a member of the Elberton Board of Tax Assessors.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Mayor and Council of the City of Elberton do hereby acknowledge the many years of commendable service and dedication provided to the Elberton Fire Department by Niles T. Poole; and
