

**CITY OF ELBERTON**  
**REGULAR MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND COUNCIL**

Monday, March 5, 2018 – 5:30 p.m.

Pursuant to due call and notice thereof the meeting of the Mayor and Council convened at 5:30 p. m. on Monday, March 5, 2018 in Council Chambers of the Municipal Building, 203 Elbert Street with Mayor Pro tem Colquitt presiding.

Present were: Council Members Butler, Colquitt, Hunt, Parham and Prince; City Attorney Jenkins, and City Manager Dunn. Absent were: Mayor Guest and City Clerk Churney.

Mayor Pro tem Colquitt called the meeting to order and led the assembly in the Pledge of Allegiance. City Attorney Jenkins led the assembly in prayer.

Council Member Butler motioned to approve the minutes of the February 5 meeting, seconded by Council Member Hunt and the motion passed unanimously (Butler, Hunt, Parham, Prince).

Mayor Pro tem Colquitt stated that consideration of adopting a Resolution to quitclaim a portion of land known as South McIntosh Street Extension located adjacent to Elbert County Tax Map E13-069 was removed from the agenda for further consideration.
