The City of Elberton is currently seeking qualified applicants for a full-time position. We offer a competitive compensation package including several fringe benefits such as Paid Vacation and Sick Leave, Paid Holidays, Group Medical and Dental Insurance, Employer Provided Life Insurance and Long-term Disability Insurance, and two Retirement Plans—a defined benefit pension plan at no cost to the employee, and a defined contribution plan that matches employee voluntary contributions up to 6% of salary.

An individual in this job classification is responsible for performing general fire work in the protection of life and property endangered by fire and other emergency situations. This involves the education, prevention and extinguishing of fires and the precaution to prevent rekindling. The work involves an element of personal danger.

Individual must be at least 18 years of age; a citizen of the United States; hold a high school diploma or equivalent; and hold a valid Georgia driver's license.

Other supplemental education expected upon hire: minimum yearly training hours as stated in the Standard Operating Procedures Manual. Part of that training will consist of 24 hours set forth by the Georgia Firefighters Standards and Training.
